OLD BUSINESS:

1. Moonshiners Snowmobile Club Lease/Contract

The T.A has contacted MMA Legal and is waiting for a response.

2. Natural Conservation Committee

The board asked the T.A. if she had heard from or received any information from the committee on the meeting scheduled for June 9, 2026. The T.A. has not heard or received any information.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Public Commentary

a. Update on MSAD #54 Budget Meeting
